

Strategies for Memorizing Scripture Verses

- Ask the Lord to help you commit scripture verses to memory.
- Look up the scripture verse in the Bible and read the surrounding verses to gain an understanding of the context.
- Write the verse on a paper or card. Cut the words apart. Each day arrange the words into the verse and read it. Save the words in an envelope and write the scripture reference on the outside of the envelope. Practice saying the verse without taking the words out of the envelope.
- Type the verse in a document substituting blanks for some of the words.
