FOLLOW JESUS

- As His disciples, we are called to follow Jesus with deep love and deep obedience.

- Love defined by the life of Jesus is the intersection of what is kind, patient, and true. (1 Corinthians 13:4-7) When love lacks any of these, it does not reflect Jesus.
