



A low-maintenance succulent known for its bright green, star-shaped foliage and its ability to thrive in a range of light conditions



Water sparingly, allowing the soil to dry out completely before watering again. Overwatering can lead to root rot



Thrives in bright, indirect light. It can also tolerate some shade



Propagate by dividing the plant or by taking stem cuttings



Typically not toxic to humans or pets
