



LAVENDER SCALLOPS

KALANCHOE FEDTSCHENKOI



Native to Madagascar, she is a flowering succulent with flat, pale green leaves that have scalloped pink edges



Requires water when soil is completely dry; typically every 2-3 weeks



Loves direct, bright sunshine, but also thrives under a grow lamp



Can be easily propagated from her leaves, as well as baby plantlets that form on the leaf's edges



Can be toxic to pets
