



PEPEROMIA
AXILLARIS

PEPEROMIA



An exotic plant with chartreuse foliage that grows in tight clumps and is shaped like peapods with a green stripe on top



Keep the soil moist, not letting it dry completely out as typical for most other succulents



Grows best in bright to moderate light, or a grow lamp



Fallen leaves can be propagated to form new baby peperomias, as leaves fall off easily (do not be alarmed by this!)



Not typically toxic
