



A slow-grower with blue-green, oblong leaves that are slightly cupped to form a tidy rosette. When grown in bright sunlight, the leaf edges have a fine, crimson outline that contrasts well with its soft blue tones



Water deeply enough for water to run out the drainage hole, then wait for the soil to fully dry before watering again



Prefers bright sunlight to maintain colors and compact rosette form



Propagates from stem cuttings or mature leaves, as well as offsets



Typically not toxic
