



SHATTERING ECHEVERIA

ECHEVERIA DIFFRACTENS



A succulent with flattened rosettes of many short, broad, pale pinkish to gray-violet leaves with a thin cream outline



Watering: the soak and dry method is preferred (water when totally dry, then soak with water, not letting any excess water sit under the plant). Overwatering can kill her



Full sun is recommended



Easily propagates from leaf cuttings



Typically not toxic to animals
