

TOM'S THUMB

CRASSULA TOM'S THUMB



Known for its compact size, unique rosette shape, and attractive plump leaves that are often have a gray-green hue



Provide bright, indirect sunlight to maintain its vibrant appearance. Avoid exposing it to direct sunlight for extended periods, as this can lead to sunburn and damage the leaves



Water sparingly, allowing the soil to dry out completely between waterings to avoid root rot



Propagate with single leaves or stem cuttings



Typically not toxic
