



COPPER SPOONS

KALANCHOE ORGYALIS



A much-branched shrubby succulent, with spatulate-ovate leaves that fold upwards. Leaves vary from bronze to gray, with the top side feeling felted



Water every 2-3 weeks in Fall/Winter, and less in the hotter months while dormant



Prefers bright, sunny location



Propagate by carefully twisting a leaf from the stem



Can be toxic
