ECHEVERIA PROLIFIC



A small succulent that forms rosettes of silvery-green leaves, with an abundance of small offsets. In early Spring, small bell-shaped flowers are known to appear



Water every 1-2 weeks as needed, not letting water sit in the rosettes, which can cause rot and/or fungus



Bright light to slight shade



Can be easily propagated from leaf cuttings



Typically not toxic
