



This plant is narrow and attractive due to its brightly colored stems and beautiful flowers. Its stems are thin and red or purple. She is one of the rarest succulent plants on the planet



Let soil dry completely between waterings before watering again (days between vary based on climate and environment)



Prefers direct sunlight (6 hours a day is ideal)



Easily propagates by stem cuttings and nodes that fall from their stem



Can be toxic
