Supplies/Materials List:

- Oil, Watercolor, Acrylic, Gouache (Marilyn teaches in Oil)
- Table Easel
- 8x 10, 9x12, 11x14, or 12x16 stretched canvas or board panel or 140lb watercolor paper
- Your choice of paint - Oil, acrylic or watercolor. Only bring odorless solvent for oils. (Gamsol)
- Basic colors required: Warm and cool red, warm and cool blue, warm and cool yellow, white and black. (Other colors are fine if you want to bring them.)
- Brushes: A basic set of flats or filberts to include: #2, #4, #6, #8, #10. Bring any other brushes that you like.
- Palette can be your choice, Marilyn prefers the Masterson palettes.
- Sketching paper or sketch book for thumbnail sketches.
- Drawing pencils and eraser
- Gloves and apron
