Re: Chiquita Canyon Landfill Response to June 20, 2025 Compliance Requirements

Dear Ms. Neal and Ms. Zmily:

Chiquita Canyon, LLC (“Chiquita”) is in receipt of the compliance requirements for the Chiquita Canyon Landfill (“Landfill”) issued by the Department of Toxic Substances Control (“DTSC”) on June 20, 2025 (the “Letter”). The Letter’s compliance requirements supersede the compliance requirements discussed in DTSC’s April 1, 2025 Summary of Violations (“SOV”), to which Chiquita responded on May 1, 2025. The Letter also memorializes the June 18, 2025, discussion between Chiquita and DTSC regarding the SOV’s compliance requirements.

Chiquita incorporates herein its May 1, 2025 letter to DTSC in response to the SOV. Chiquita continues to disagree with the violations alleged in the SOV for the reasons set forth in its May 1, 2025 letter, as none of the SOV’s alleged violations and requested corrective actions are supported by the factual circumstances or the regulatory citations. Nevertheless, Chiquita remains committed to cooperating with reasonable requests for information that are within the scope of DTSC’s authority and applicable to the Landfill. Chiquita provides the following requested information in response to the Letter. The information, documents, and attachments provided herein should not be construed as an admission of any factual allegation or legal

conclusion in the Letter of SOV or an admission of any liability for any matter described in the Letter or SOV.

Allegation #1: Land Disposal Restriction Requirements

DTSC confirmed in the Letter that the documentation Chiquita previously submitted satisfied the agency's compliance requirements, and no further action is required. Chiquita will continue to comply with land disposal restriction requirements as set forth in more detail in its May 1, 2025 letter.

Allegation #2A – Release Notifications

DTSC requested in the Letter that Chiquita continue to include DTSC on the Condition 27(e) Reports (submitted to the South Coast Air Quality Management District (“SCAQMD”)), Condition 27(c) Reports (submitted to SCAQMD), Wastewater Discharge Requirements (“WDR”) Reports (submitted to the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (“Water Board”), and 30-Day Storm Event Reports (submitted to the Water Board). DTSC also requested in the Letter that, to the extent reasonably possible, Chiquita include the following additional information in the aforementioned reports:

- The estimated release cleanup time;
- A waste determination of the release;
- Tank number (if applicable);
- Well number (if applicable);
- Train identification (if applicable);
- Photographs (if taken); and
- Sampling results (if taken).

Chiquita already provides much of the information requested above, as follows:

- **Condition 27(c) Reports** - Chiquita submits these reports to SCAQMD pursuant to the modified Stipulated Order for Abatement in Case No. 6177-4 (“SOFA”) and provides the grid number, map location, time discovered, estimated duration of presence of leachate, estimated quantity of leachate, extent of impact, photographs, corrective actions taken, and more for each leachate leak or spill, to the extent available. Chiquita now provides DTSC with copies of these reports consistent with DTSC's request during our meeting on June 18, 2025.
- **Condition 27(e) Reports** - Chiquita submits these reports to SCAQMD pursuant to the SOFA and provides the date and time, grid number, waste determination, corrective actions taken, and more for each leachate leak or spill, to the extent available. Chiquita now provides DTSC with copies of these reports consistent with DTSC's request during our meeting on June 18, 2025.
- **Waste Discharge Requirements (“WDRs”) Reports** - Chiquita submits these reports to the Water Board pursuant to its WDRs and provides a map location, grid number, waste

determination, sampling results, and more for each leachate leak or spill that occurs outside of the Landfill's footprint, to the extent available. Chiquita now provides DTSC with copies of these reports consistent with DTSC's request during our meeting on June 18, 2025.

- **30-Day Storm Event Reports** - Chiquita submits these reports to the Water Board pursuant to Investigative Order No. R4-2024-0010 and provides sampling results and analysis of discharges into and out of the south sedimentation basin. Chiquita now provides DTSC with copies of these reports consistent with DTSC's request during our meeting on June 18, 2025.

Chiquita also engages with DTSC and the other regulators participating in the Leachate Unit, responding to follow up questions posed at regular meetings, and providing available information as requested on an incident-by-incident basis.

Chiquita continues to follow its protocol to make waste determinations of releases as required by law. These waste determinations are incorporated in the aforementioned reports when the information is known. For example, a Condition 27(e) Report may state that a leak or spill consisted of "treated leachate" and is therefore nonhazardous; similarly, a WDR Report may state that a leak or spill involved "leachate that is characteristically non-hazardous." When a leak or spill occurs from a tank or in an area that may be hazardous, but has not previously been sampled, the material is handled assuming that it is hazardous. If absorbent material is used to clean up, it is not separately characterized until the roll off is filled and ready for disposal. If a leak or spill is large enough to be vacuumed, it is added to a tank that will be treated (or retreated) regardless of whether it is suspected to be hazardous. Chiquita has updated its reporting practices to specify when it is managing a spill or leak as hazardous, even if it does not have confirmation sampling.

Consistent with our discussion on June 18, 2025, Chiquita is also providing an estimated release cleanup time when feasible. When leaks or spills occur, Chiquita and its contractors immediately implement cleanup protocol, which requires a swift response. Because of the speed and urgency that responding to these situations require, Chiquita and its contractors cannot always pause to note the time that cleanup concluded. However, Chiquita provides the date and time that the leak or spill was discovered and describes the cleanup actions it engages in, providing duration of its cleanup actions when feasible. Any estimated release times should be considered as a rough metric, intended only to provide a sense of the duration, and not a reliable indicator of precise timing.

Chiquita will continue to include DTSC in the aforementioned reports and provide the information requested. Where applicable, Chiquita will also provide tank number, well number, group identification,¹ photographs, and sampling results.

¹ Chiquita understands DTSC's request for "train identification" to refer to the leachate group identification. Chiquita uses the term "train" to refer to the treatment train, but does not use "train" for identification purposes. Early in the response, Chiquita colloquially referred to Groups A and B as "trains" when referring to certain banks of tanks, but that terminology was retired to avoid confusion when the treatment train was introduced into the process.

Count 3 (3/13/25):

This release occurred in Grid 178, Group A. No tank number is available, because the release was from a pipe.

Count 5 (1/23/25):

This release occurred in Tank Farm 7, Grid 246, Group A. No tank number has been located, as that information was not recorded at the time.

Count 7 (1/6/25):

This release occurred in Grids 74 and 79, North Perimeter. No tank number has been located, as that information was not recorded at the time.

Count 19 (10/24/24):

This release occurred in Grid 81. No tank number or group identification is available, because the release was from a vacuum line and involved a mixture of liquid. As such, there was no group to identify, and tank number was not recorded at the time.

Count 23 (10/17/24):

This release occurred in Tank Farm 7. No tank number or group identification is available, because the release was from a hose.

Count 26 (10/9/24):

This release occurred in Grid 156, Group A.

Count 30 (9/8/24):

This release occurred south of Cell 8B. No tank number or group identification is available, because the release was from a truck that was moving leachate from one tank farm to another.

Count 31 (9/8/24):

This release occurred in Grids 77, 145, and 150. No well number or group identification information is available, because the release was a seep.

Count 33 (9/4/24):

This release occurred in the North Slope, Grid 150, North Perimeter. No well number is available, because the release was from a discharge hose line connected to a well pump.

Count 40 (2/19/24):

This release occurred in Grid 77. No well number is available, because the release was a seep.

Count 41 (2/7/24):

This release occurred in Grid 142, Primary Canyon, and involved characteristically non-hazardous condensate. Estimated volume and more detailed information about the cause have not been located, as that information was not recorded at the time.

Count 42 (1/31/24):

This release occurred in Grid 240 and 246. No tank number is available, because the release was from a third-party loader truck.

Allegation #2A: Information Request for Releases Since April 1, 2025

DTSC requested that Chiquita provide additional information for 8 specific releases. Chiquita has examined its files and provides the additional information it has identified below. Where applicable, Chiquita provides an explanation of why the information is unavailable.

1. 6/19/2025 release: Tank number and train identification
2. 6/16/2025 release: Tank number
3. 6/12/2025 release (at 0800 hours): Tank number
4. 6/11/2025 release: Hazardous waste manifest for the shipment
5. 5/27/2025 release: Well number and train identification

6/19/2025 Release:

This release occurred in Tank Farm 7, Grid 239. Chiquita met with the Leachate Disposal Unit (“LDU”) and provided additional information in response to the regulators’ questions in the Teams Channel. Treated leachate had mixed with water from the granulated activated carbon (“GAC”) changeout and spilled from a hose connected to a manifold in Tank Farm 7, located in Grid 239. The release was cleaned up, and fresh soil was added to the impacted area. There is no group identification available, because the release occurred post-treatment.

6/16/2025 Release:

This release occurred in Grid 245. No tank number is available, because the release was from a pressure release valve on the trailer of a third-party haul truck.

6/12/2025 Release:

This release occurred in Tank Farm 7, Grid 239. No tank number is available, because the release was from a third-party haul truck.

6/11/2025 Release

Chiquita provides the requested hazardous waste manifest for the shipment of the material associated with this release in **Attachment 1**.

5/27/2025 Release:

This release occurred in Grid 150, Group A, well number CV-24030.

5/21/2025 Release:

This release occurred in Grids 79 and 89. No group identification is available, because the release was from the leachate collection system.

4/10/2025 Release:

This release occurred in Grid 241. Chiquita met with the LDU and provided additional information in response to the regulators' questions in the Teams Channel. During pipe maintenance, nonhazardous leachate heading to LCM was released due to gravity draining from residuals in the line. The release was cleaned up, and the affected soils were disposed of in the active face of the Landfill. No group identification is available, because the release was from a pipe.

4/8/2025 Release:

This release occurred in Grid 227. Chiquita met with the LDU and provided additional information in response to the regulators' questions in the Teams Channel. On April 11, 2025 at 11:13 a.m. Pacific Time, Chiquita explained that the release came from a line that feeds Group B.

Allegation #2A – Releases Involving Hauler Trucks

DTSC requested that Chiquita provide a written plan describing how Chiquita will mitigate and prevent releases involving hauler trucks. Chiquita currently follows its Leachate Management Plan to respond to leachate seeps or other releases.² This protocol also governs Chiquita's response to releases involving hauler trucks. Additionally, Chiquita understands that its hauler contractors have procedures in place for responding to releases from hauler trucks, as it is ultimately the hauler's responsibility to prevent releases involving hauler trucks.

Chiquita therefore already takes substantial steps to minimize these types of releases. Chiquita is nevertheless regularly evaluating its mitigation measures to determine if additional measures can be taken to minimize future releases, including those involving hauler trucks, and will update its protocols if further steps are identified in the future.

Allegation #2B – Written Statement and Tank Farm Movement Notification

DTSC confirmed in the Letter that a written statement within 30 days of issuance of the SOV and Tank Farm Movement Notification are no longer required. Chiquita will continue to cooperate with DTSC's Site Mitigation Program, submit deliverables, and complete tasks related to the relocation of Tank Farm 9 in a timely manner. Chiquita will also continue to forward copies of relevant reports, including the implementation report for the relocation of Tank Farm 9.

Allegation #2B – Well Field and Tank Farm Maps

DTSC confirmed in the letter that it would like Chiquita to submit well field and tank farm maps to DTSC on a quarterly basis, with the first submission to be provided on July 25, 2025 and subsequent submissions by the 20th day after the start of the quarter. Chiquita provides the most recent well field map in **Attachment 2**³ and the most recent tank farm map in **Attachment 3**.

Allegation #2B – Isopach, Landfill Settlement, and Maximum Vertical Temperature Maps

DTSC confirmed in the Letter that Chiquita shall submit isopach, landfill settlement, and maximum vertical temperature maps from temperature probes to DTSC at the frequency prescribed by the Local Enforcement Agency ("LEA"). Chiquita will ensure that DTSC is copied on these submittals to the LEA.

Other DTSC Issues/Concerns #1 – Information Request for SOV Table 2 Incidents

DTSC requested that Chiquita provide additional information for 18 specific incidents. Chiquita has examined its files and provides the additional information it has identified below. Where applicable, Chiquita provides an explanation of why the information is unavailable.

1. Incident 1 (3/22/2025): Train identification
2. Incident 3 (2/25/2025): Well number and train identification
3. Incident 4 (2/9/2025): Train identification
4. Incident 8 (1/20/2025): Train identification

³ The well map shows the grouping for the pumps and tanks, including the general routing for the pump routes to each discharge line. However, the map does not show the exact locations of each line, which would be burdensome to develop.

Incident 1:

This release occurred in Tank Farm 9. No group identification is available, because the release involved a mixture of liquid in a vacuum line that released due to high pressure caused by an unknown mechanical issue.

Incident 3:

This release occurred in Grid 77. No well number or group identification information has been located, as that information was not recorded at the time.

Incident 4:

This release occurred in Grid 227, Group B.

Incident 8:

This release occurred in Grid 36. No group identification is available, because the release was from a force main port valve.

Incident 13:

This release occurred in Grid 78 due to a malfunctioning pump. No group identification is available, because the release was near a pump.

Incident 16:

This release occurred from a truck within Grid 247. Upon discovering the spill, Chiquita immediately closed the valve to the truck, and then added absorbent to the non-hazardous leachate. Chiquita removed any contaminated soil and replaced it with fresh soil. Cleanup commenced immediately and was completed the same day. No tank number or group identification is available, because the release involved a third-party hauler truck.

Incident 17:

This release occurred in Grid 247, LCM, and involved characteristically non-hazardous liquid. No tank number is available, because the release was from a truck hose.

This release involved Tank 1, LCM, and involved characteristically non-hazardous liquid. The release occurred within the containment area of the leachate collection system near the front office.

Incident 30:

This release occurred in Grid 93. No well number or group identification information has been located, as that information was not recorded at the time.

Incident 36:

This release involved an overfilled tank and a release into secondary containment. No tank number, group identification, or grid location has been located, as that information was not recorded at the time.

Incident 45:

Force main piping and other gas and liquid infrastructure were temporarily removed from the affected area to install the geosynthetic cover in early May 2024.

Incident 46:

This release occurred in Grid 208. No well number or group identification is available, because the release involved a leak from a valve. No information about the volume of leachate involved has been located, as that information was not recorded at the time.

Incident 50:

This release occurred in Grid 210. No group identification is available, because the release involved a leachate transportation line.

Incident 51:

This release involved Grids 77 and 145. No group identification is available, because the release was from an open valve leaking leachate.

Incident 52:

This release involved Grids 186 and 187. No well number or group identification information has been located, as that information was not recorded at the time.

Incident 54:

This release involved Tank Farm 9. No group identification is available, as the release involved a mixture of liquid.

Incident 62:

This release involved Grid 145. No well number is available, because the release was from a pipe.

Incident 71:

This release involved Grid 78. No well number is available, because the release was a seep.



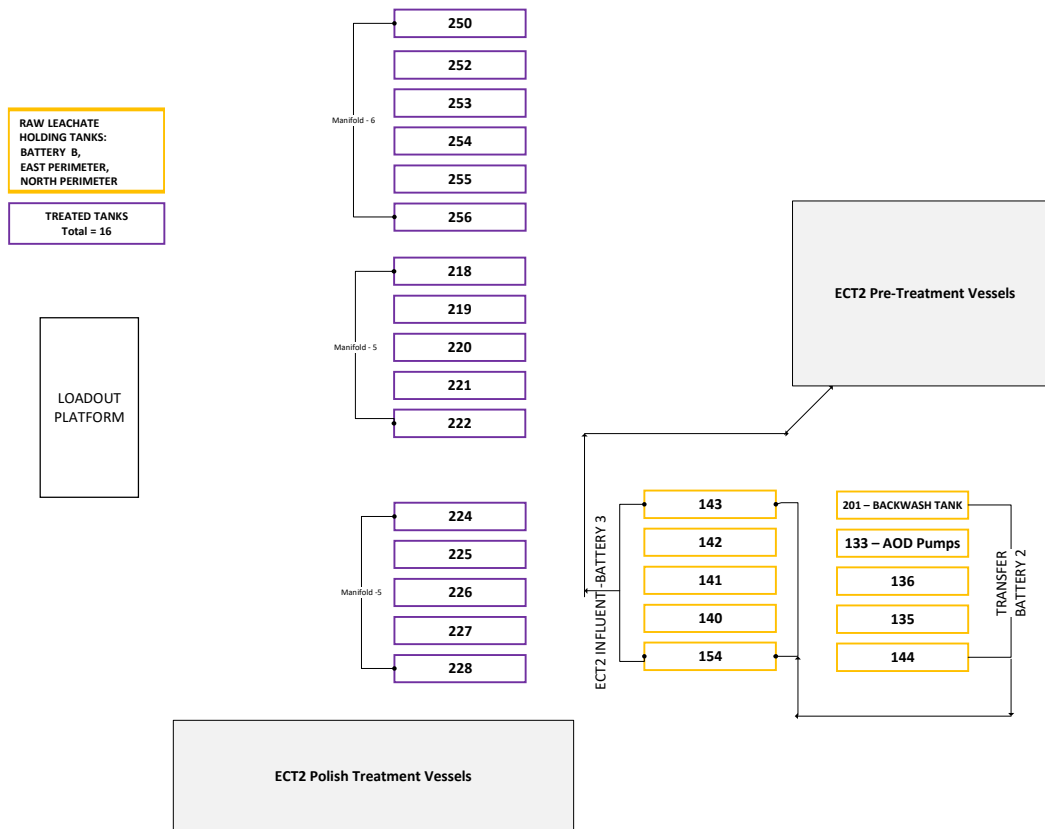

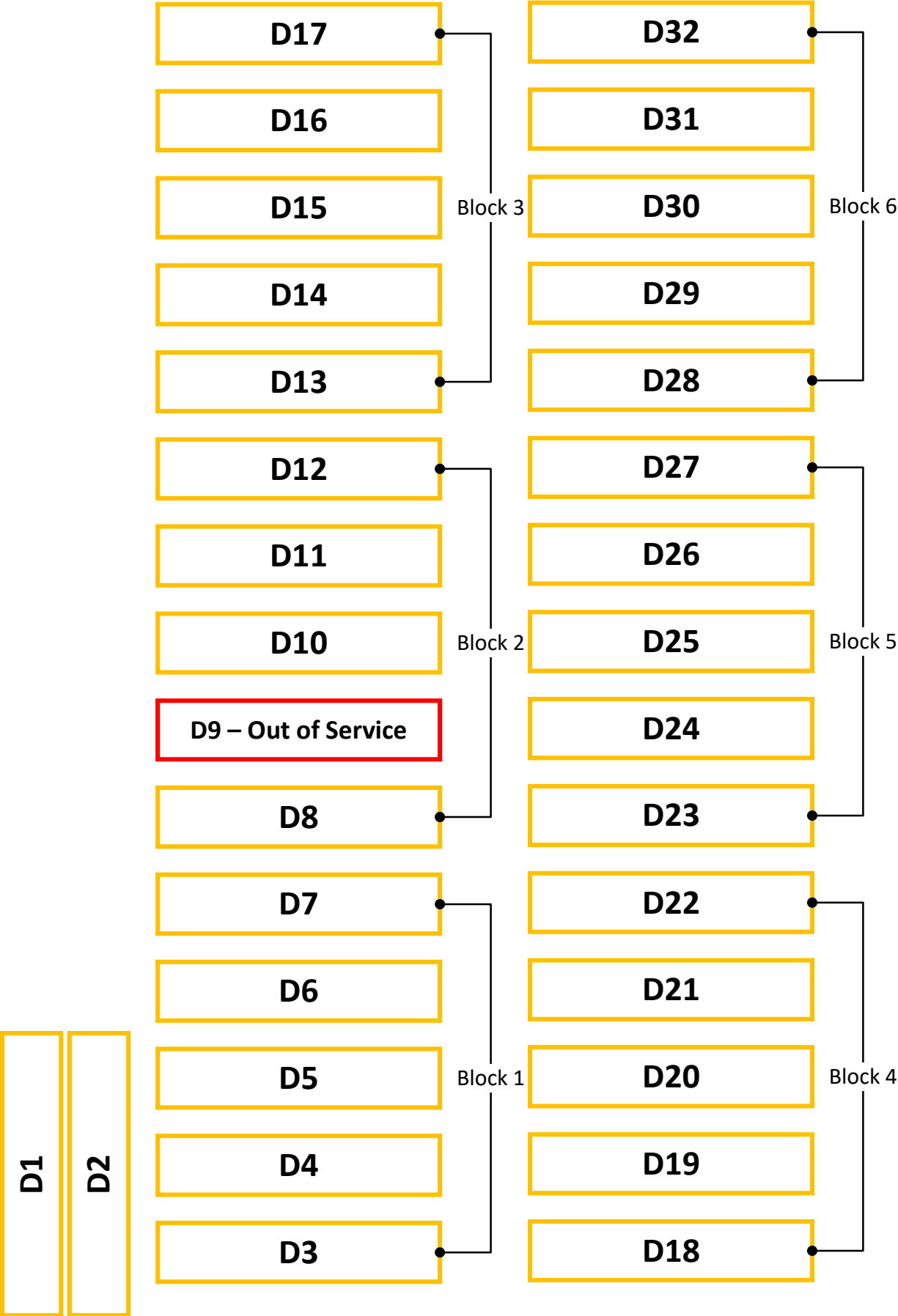
Tank Farm 9 Layout
