Provide all records necessary to demonstrate compliance with the Portable Equipment Registration Program (PERP). Provide the following documentation and information for the three registered units: McCloskey Trommel Screen, Crushing Plant by Eagle Crusher Co., and Maximus Conveying Screen that are currently operating at the site:

- copy of the rental or service contract between RandFam and CCL for each of the three pieces of portable equipment.
- date each piece of equipment began operating at the site and the expected duration of its operation at this location.
- information on whether this equipment replaced any previous equipment or operator performing the same function (e.g., aggregate processing services). If so, include the make, model, and function of the replaced equipment and/or the name of the previous operator.

Please submit all records by the **close of business day 10/3/2025.**
