

Value criterion: Cosmopolitanism - All kinds of ethnic groups have a responsibility towards one another

1) US has moral obligation

Value criterion: dualism

1) Intervention is illegal
→ UN Charter says there is a right to intervene in extreme cases (aggression)
→ off rebuts → not moral to deny humans rights






