REINSTATEMENT OF THE C.C.C.

- Whereas: There continues to be a rise in unemployment nationwide, and
- Whereas: This unemployment continues to be a drain on both the state and national economy, and
- Whereas: There are national disasters occurring annually from forest fires to flood to weather related issues such as tornadoes and hurricanes, and:
- Whereas State and local services are too often strained by these demands, and;
- Whereas: Reinstating the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) would provide states with individuals to help in times of distress.
- Therefore: Be it resolved by the Student Congress here assembled that the United States Congress must reestablishes the CCC.

A Resolution to Allow Trans-gender Students Freedom of Choice

- WHEREAS: In so far as public school facilities and restrooms in the United States of America have historically been segregated into male and female, and;
- WHEREAS: There exists in today's society, young people who identify with a gender that is opposite of their current biology, who consider themselves to be trans-gender, and;
- WHEREAS: These students are uncomfortable using a restroom contrary to their sexual Identity preference, and may feel threatened and consider themselves to be discriminated against.
- THEREFORE: Be it resolved by this Congress here assembled that all public schools in the United States must allow students that deem themselves trans-gender to use the facilities and restrooms of their personal preference.
