Public Forum: Resolved: In United States public K-12 schools, the probable cause standard ought to apply to searches of students.
Debate Rules:
There will be 4 rounds. for LD, Parli and Public Forum. There will be 3 rounds for Policy. We will accept hybrid teams We do not accept single persons in team debate; team debate must be two person. Computers are

allowed in all events except during the Parliamentary round speeches. Phones can be used as timers. Prep Time will be printed on the ballot.

## Judges Rules:

Judges are assumed to be experienced and prepared to judge their assigned events or debate formats. Debate judges are free to determine style questions at the beginning of each round. School judges who fail to check in at the judging table when assigned may have their team fined the aforementioned penalties per round.
