Cultural Artifact Speech

Guidelines

Description: Bring a cultural artifact and give a presentation about the object. An artifact can be an item/object, or costume that you feel represents a culture or heritage. Competitors are encouraged, but not required, to present on an object from their culture.

Visual Aid: You must bring in an actual object, not a photo. The object should not be passed around during your speech or another competitor's speech. A table will be set up in the speaking area for competitors to display their artifact. Competitors are allowed to pick up their artifact during the speech to highlight specific aspects of the object.

The time limit for this speech is 6 minutes max.

Judging Criteria:

- Standard public speaking principles including but not limited to vocal variety, body control, eye contact
- Cultural significance of the object
- Originality of the object
- Speech structure: Intro, body, conclusion
