- Each entry must include a cover page containing the following:
 - Competitor's full name
 - Name of academy or school
 - Student's age group (Elementary, Middle, or High School)
 - o Pattern D
- Academies/schools must email all entries at the same time.
- Each entry must be a separate attachment to the email.
- Word limit **not** to exceed
 - o Elementary and middle school entries: 750 words
 - o High school: 1000 words
