WHEREAS, This resolution expresses opposition to Proposition 16 from the upcoming election cycle.; and;

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WHEREAS, Proposition 16 seeks to repeal Proposition 209 from Section 31 of
Article I in the California Constitution.

Proposition 209 is as follows:

- 24 **RESOLVED**, By the Congress here assembled that Prop. 16 is racially
- discriminatory, violates the U.S. Constitution and will bring more harm than good
- to the state of California.
