Maximum Speaker Points for IPDA: 40

**IPDA:** [International Public Debate Association] 5 topics will be provided for strikes. **Thirty minutes** total preparation time is allowed for the debate. The preparation time will begin once the topics are given to the Negative for the first strike. Then turns are taken until one topic remains to be debated. The debate proposition will be restated by the judge. There is no preparation time allowed between speeches. Debaters will not be allowed to consult any other person during prep time. Per IPDA rules, they will be allowed paper and/or electronic research material, which may be quoted or paraphrased from notes during the round, but not read directly, as extemporaneous delivery is required.

Maximum Speaker Points for **PARLI**: 30

**PARLIAMENTARY DEBATE:** Five topics will be used in both preliminary and elimination rounds. These resolutions will include 2 policy, 2 value and 1 metaphor per round. The judge will first give the list to the Opposition who will strike one of the five topics within one minute. Next, the judge will give the list to the Government who will strike one of the four remaining topics within one minute. This process will continue until 1 topic remains. The remaining topic will be debated in that round. The debate proposition will be restated by the judge in the room prior to preparation time, which will then begin immediately. Each team shall be allotted twenty (20) minutes total preparation time for the debate. The Government team may leave the room during the preparation period. No coaching is allowed during the preparation period. Debaters will not be allowed to consult any other person during prep time. During prep, debaters will be allowed paper, dictionaries, almanacs and/or electronic research material. Except for notes that the debaters themselves have prepared during prep time, no published materials, prepared arguments, or resources may be used during the debate. Any team not ready to strike topics 5 minutes after the posted start time will be forfeited by the judge and reported to the Ombuds. Any team not returning after prep time has elapsed (typically less than 2 minutes) will be forfeited by the judge.
