A Bill to Fund the Additional Cleanup of the Great Pacific Garbage Patch

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1	SECTION 1.	Because animals who try to swim through the Great Pacific	
2	Garbage Patch sometimes get choked or injured, AND because the floating		
3	debris in the ocean is a great health concern to all human beings, we		
4	should put in place the means to clean the Great Pacific Garbage Patch.		
5	SECTION 2.	The Great Pacific Garbage Patch is a 1.6 million square	
6	kilometers collection of garbage in the North Pacific Ocean harming all life		
7	on earth.		
8	SECTION 3.	This legislation will be overseen by the Environmental	
9	Protection Agency		
10	SECTION 4.	This legislation will take effect on February 3, 2021. All laws	
11	in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.		

A Bill to Reduce the Ratio of Patient to Nurse in Health Care Facilities

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1	SECTION 1.	Nurses are on the front line of all health care emergencies	
2	and require the ability to fully care for all the patients in their care		
3	SECTION 2.	Current Patient to Nurse ratios are in flux depending on the	
4	facility, but optimally the patient to nurse ratio should be 2:1 in critical care		
5	facilities and only 4:1 when patients are receiving care.		
6	SECTION 3.	This bill will nationalize patient to nurse ratios, requiring all	
7	accredited institutions to follow these guidelines.		
8	SECTION 4.	This bill will be enforced through the accreditation done by	
9	the Department of Health		
10	SECTION 5.	This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2022. All laws in	
11	conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.		

A Bill to Reduce/Eliminate Greenhouse Gas Emissions from Industrial Workplaces

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1	SECTION 1	All industrial workplaces will be required to replace non-	
2		ergy sources with renewable energy sources.	
3	SECTION 2 facilities, or w	A. Industrial workplaces are defined as any plants, factories, varehouses that manufacture goods and items.	
4	B. Non-renewable energy sources are defined as any natural		
5	sources of energy that are consumed faster than can be		
6	replenished and emit greenhouse gases and renewable energy		
7	sources are defined as any natural sources of energy that can be replenished and do not emit any harmful substances.		
8	SECTION 3	The Environmental Protection Agency will oversee the	
9	implementation of this bill.		
10	A. Industrial workplaces that comply with this legislation will be		
11	awarded a grant of \$25,000		
	B. Industrial workplaces that do not comply with this legislation will		
12	be fined \$50,000		
13	SECTION 4	This bill will go into effect two years after passage	
14	SECTION 5	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared	
15	null and void.
