

A Bill to Fund the Additional Cleanup of the Great Pacific Garbage Patch

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1 **SECTION 1.** Because animals who try to swim through the Great Pacific
2 Garbage Patch sometimes get choked or injured, AND because the floating
3 debris in the ocean is a great health concern to all human beings, we
4 should put in place the means to clean the Great Pacific Garbage Patch.

5 **SECTION 2.** The Great Pacific Garbage Patch is a 1.6 million square
6 kilometers collection of garbage in the North Pacific Ocean harming all life
7 on earth.

8 **SECTION 3.** This legislation will be overseen by the Environmental
9 Protection Agency

10 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on February 3, 2021. All laws
11 in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Reduce the Ratio of Patient to Nurse in Health Care Facilities

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1 **SECTION 1.** Nurses are on the front line of all health care emergencies
2 and require the ability to fully care for all the patients in their care

3 **SECTION 2.** Current Patient to Nurse ratios are in flux depending on the
4 facility, but optimally the patient to nurse ratio should be 2:1 in critical care
5 facilities and only 4:1 when patients are receiving care.

6 **SECTION 3.** This bill will nationalize patient to nurse ratios, requiring all
7 accredited institutions to follow these guidelines.

8 **SECTION 4.** This bill will be enforced through the accreditation done by
9 the Department of Health

10 **SECTION 5.** This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2022. All laws in
11 conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Reduce/Eliminate Greenhouse Gas Emissions from Industrial Workplaces

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1 **SECTION 1** All industrial workplaces will be required to replace non-renewable energy sources with renewable energy sources.

2 **SECTION 2** A. Industrial workplaces are defined as any plants, factories, facilities, or warehouses that manufacture goods and items.

3 B. Non-renewable energy sources are defined as any natural sources of energy that are consumed faster than can be replenished and emit greenhouse gases and renewable energy sources are defined as any natural sources of energy that can be replenished and do not emit any harmful substances.

4 **SECTION 3** The Environmental Protection Agency will oversee the implementation of this bill.

5 A. Industrial workplaces that comply with this legislation will be awarded a grant of \$25,000

6 B. Industrial workplaces that do not comply with this legislation will be fined \$50,000

7 **SECTION 4** This bill will go into effect two years after passage

8 **SECTION 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
