Sunshine Protection Act of 2021

- 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
- 2 Section 1: This bill makes daylight savings time the new, permanent
- 3 standard time.
- 4 Section 2: States with areas exempt from daylight savings time may
- 5 choose the standard time for those areas.
- 6 Section 3: The Department of Transportation (DOT) shall oversee the
- 7 implementation of this bill.
- 8 Section 4: This bill shall go into effect at 2:00 AM on Sunday,
- 9 November 6, 2022.
- 10 Section 5: All other laws that are in conflict with this new policy
- 11 shall hereby be declared null and void.

A National Holiday to Celebrate John Adams

- 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
- 2 Section 1: Upon passage of this bill, the United States Federal
- 3 Government shall create a national holiday to celebrate John
- 4 Adams' efforts in democracy and bringing the USA into being.
- 5 Section 2: John Adam's birthday is October 30th. This day will be
- 6 a federally observed day; all federal buildings will be closed,
- 7 along with schools, libraries, and courts.
- 8 Section 3: In accordance with Title V code, this Congress has
- 9 authority to create federal holidays.
- 10 Section 4: This bill will take effect beginning January 1, 2023.
- 11 Section 5: All other laws that are in conflict with this new policy
- 12 shall hereby be declared null and void.

Privatization of the Postal Service

- 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
- 2 Section 1: The United States Postal Service shall be privatized,
- 3 and would cut all business ties to the United States Federal
- 4 Government.
- 5 Section 2: Privatization of the USPS would require that the
- 6 organization no longer be owned and operated by the government.
- 7 Section 3: The Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs Committee
- 8 will ensure that the privatization is done in accordance with
- 9 standing laws. The USPS will issue stocks that would be
- 10 available for purchase by the general public.
- 11 Section 4: This bill shall go into effect on January 1st, 2023
- 12 Section 5: All other laws that are in conflict with this new policy
- 13 shall hereby be declared null and void.
