Changes or drops after Tuesday. October 26th, 2021 at 12:00 p.m. PST will be charged a \$10 nuisance fee for each change or drop. Judges changes after October 27th 12:05 a.m. PST will be charged a \$50 judge nuisance fee. Judge drops after this date will be charged a \$100 judge noshow fee.

Students who miss the first round will be dropped from the tournament unless their coach has notified the tournament staff ahead of time. Dropped students will incur a \$30 drop fee.
