Best Practices for Online Competition

While most of had never attended an online tournament before 2020, the past two years have taught us a few things about how to compete, judge, and run online tournaments effectively. In addition to NOF tournament [guides](#) available for [competitors](#), [judges](#), and [coaches](#), we wanted to draw your attention to a few best practices:



Timing: Arrive to your 8x8 competition room early to give yourself time to make sure all your tech is working.



Cameras: Competitors & judges please have your cameras on to give feedback to the students. Mute mic when not presenting.



Empty room: If you are in an empty competition room when you should have other competitors & judges, you may be in the wrong spot. Head to the help room.



Help Room: Bookmark the NOF Help room (<https://8x8.vc/NOFHelp>) where tournament staff will be available to assist if anything is wrong.

How will Limited Prep work?

ANSWER

- Impromptu topics will be provided to each competitor in the Live Video Room (their competition room) chat box. Judges will need to copy/paste the topics (provided on the eBallots) in the chat window for the competitors.
- Each competitor will receive a different set of impromptu topics.
- Extemp questions will be provided for all speakers in a separate Extemp Prep Live Video Room. Competitors do not need to stay in the Extemp Prep Room after receiving the questions. The extemp proctor will copy/paste the questions into the chat window at the specified time.
