# **Best Practices for Online Competition**

While most of had never attended an online tournament before 2020, the past two years have taught us a few things about how to compete, judge, and run online tournaments effectively. In addition to NOF tournament guides available for competitors, judges, and coaches, we wanted to draw your attention to a few best practices:



Timing: Arrive to your 8x8 competition room early to give yourself time to make sure all your tech is working.



Cameras: Competitors & judges please have your cameras on to give feedback to the students. Mute mic when not presenting.



Empty room: If you are in an empty competition room when you should have other competitors & judges, you may be in the wrong spot. Head to the help room.



Help Room: Bookmark the NOF Help room (<a href="https://8x8.vc/NOFHelp">https://8x8.vc/NOFHelp</a>) where tournament staff will be available to assist if anything is wrong.

- College Oral Interp with Mikayla Holzinger




