1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2. **Section 1** Upon passage of this bill, the United States Federal Government

3. shall create a national holiday to celebrate John Adams' efforts in

4. democracy and bringing the USA into being.

5. **Section 2** John Adam's birthday is October 30th. This day will be a federally

6. observed day; all federal buildings will be closed, along with schools,

7. libraries, and courts.

8. **Section 3** In accordance with Title V code, this Congress has authority to

9. create federal holidays.

10. **Section 4** This bill will take effect beginning January 1, 2023.

11. **Section 5** All other laws that are in conflict with this new policy shall

12. hereby be declared null and void.

A Bill to Allow for School Choice

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2. **Section 1** All legal US residents under the age of 18 shall be provided a

3. financial voucher to be used at the school of their choice. All other

4. federal school funding being provided shall immediately cease.

5. **Section 2** The amount due to each student by way of voucher is to calculate

6. the current rate being spent (directly and through federal grants), and

7. then divide this number by the total number of minors in the United

8. States. The federal voucher will then be given directly to any accredited

9. school that the minor chooses to attend.

10. **Section 3** The Department of Education shall oversee the implementation of

11. this bill.

12. **Section 4** This bill shall go into effect on August 1st, 2023.

13. **Section 5** All other laws that are in conflict with this new policy shall

14. hereby be declared null and void.

Resolution to Ban use of Non-Organic Pesticides

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:**

1. **WHEREAS**, Non-organic pesticides can be toxic to humans and can build up in

2. the human body contributing significantly to disease; and

3. **WHEREAS**, 547 average deaths a year have been related to pesticide poisoning;

4. and

5. **WHEREAS**, organophosphate-induced protein deformation, Alzheimer's and related

6. diseases have been frequently related to causes from non-organic

7. pesticides; and

8. **WHEREAS**, mental instability has also been a side effect of pesticides running

9. into drinking water; therefore be it

10. **RESOLVED**, that all non-organic pesticides be replaced with organic or

11. natural pesticides.

A Resolution to Promote Foreign Languages in Elementary School

5. **WHEREAS**, other competing foreign countries teach their students at least one

6. other language from an early age; and

7. **WHEREAS**, knowing multiple languages is beneficial in today's job market;

8. now, therefore,

9. **RESOLVED**, by the Student Congress here assembled that in beginning the 2023

10. school year, all elementary school should incorporate at least one foreign

11. language into their curriculum for all grades.

A Bill to Privatize Amtrak

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:**

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2. **Section 1** The National Railroad Passenger Corporation, or Amtrak, shall be

3. privatized.

4. **Section 2** Privatization of Amtrak is defined as changing from governmental to

5. private control and ownership through the sale of preferred stock and

6. de-federalizing the appointment of Amtrak's board of directors. Amtrak's

7. preferred stock will be saleable upon passage of this bill and Amtrak's

8. Board of Directors managed by the corporation's owners.

9. **Section 3** The Department of Transportation will oversee the enforcement of

10. this Bill, which is binding to all parties in agreement to Section 1 and

11. has the same effect as if arrived at by agreement of the parties under the

12. Railway Labor Act.

13. **Section 4** This bill shall go into effect on January 1st, 2024.

14. **Section 5** All other laws that are in conflict with this new policy shall

15. hereby be declared null and void.
