Colleagues,

On behalf of the Pi Kappa Delta chapters at Northwest Nazarene University, Nampa, and Boise State University, Boise, it is our pleasure to invite you and your students to attend and compete in what promises to be two special forensics events in January, 2011!

On Saturday, January 8, 2011, you are invited to a one-day individual events tournament on the campus of Northwest Nazarene University. Three rounds of competition will be held in all high school individual speaking events (see information posted in the invitation for specifics). We will offer both a Rookie and Varsity division in all events (see additional information in this invite for qualifications for divisions). If a division fails to make the minimum qualifying number, the event will be collapsed but we will still recognize those that would have placed in their separate division with their own awards. Awards will be given to those who finish in the top 30% (top 10% - Superior, next 20% - Excellent) as well as Honorable Mentions (next 30%) according to the Pi Kappa Delta awards system.

The following weekend, On Friday and Saturday, January 14 and 15, 2011, there will be a two-day debate tournament on the campus of Boise State University. There will be a Rookie and Open division in all debate formats (see information later in the invitation for Rookie and Open qualifications). We will also offer Student Congress as well as two individual events students may enter if they do not make debate out rounds. Again, if a division fails to garner the minimum required entries, divisions will be collapsed but those earning awards in their own division will be recognized. Those who qualify for elimination rounds will be recognized with awards as well as a specified number who did not advance will earn honorable mention awards.

Beautiful Sweepstakes awards will be presented to schools in two divisions at both tournaments, large entry and small entry. Additionally, for schools that compete at both tournaments, there will be special Grand Sweepstakes awards presented at the conclusion of the Boise State hosted event! There will also be a Quality Award presented to the school who achieves the highest number of points per entry.

Pi Kappa Delta, the nation's oldest collegiate forensics honorary looks forward to hosting you for two special events that we know will be a highlight of your competitive year!
