### **Sweepstakes**

*Individual Events Sweepstakes* (top 5 entrants in an event count toward sweepstakes)

Prelim points 1<sup>st</sup> = 3; 2<sup>nd</sup> = 2; 3<sup>rd</sup> = 1

Final round points 1<sup>st</sup> = 12; 2<sup>nd</sup> = 10; 3<sup>rd</sup> = 8; 4<sup>th</sup> = 6; 5<sup>th</sup> = 4; 6<sup>th</sup> = 2; semi-finals = 1

*Debate Sweepstakes* (top 5 entrants in a division count toward sweepstakes)

Prelim points: 6 points per win for NPDA; 3 points per win for NFA LD

NPDA Octos=2, Quarter 4, Semi-Finals 8, 2<sup>nd</sup> 10, 1<sup>st</sup> 12

NFA LD Octos-1, Quarter 2, Semi-Finals 4, 2<sup>nd</sup> 5, 1<sup>st</sup> 6

*Overall Sweepstakes*

A team must enter both individual events and debate to be eligible.

The total percentage of IE points + the total percentage of debate points will be a team's score.

### **Divisions**

A top novice award will be given in all Individual Events.

There will be an open and novice division in both forms debate if entries warrant it.

### **Novice / JV Definitions**

*Individual Events:* Any competitor in their first year of college competition.

*JV NPDA :* Any student in their first two years of college competition.

### **IE Pentathlon**

A competitor must be entered in five events with one from each genre (platform, interp, and limited prep) to be eligible. Only one duo will count toward a competitor's total. 1<sup>st</sup> thru 6<sup>th</sup> place will be awarded.

**Extemp Prep:**

The use of computer soft files in extemp is permitted, however use of the internet for research and consultation after prep has begun for each round is not.

**NPDA Notes:**

Use of any resource available to a debater will be allowed during the preparation period. Use of prepared material during the round is prohibited. Wireless internet will be available in most places on campus. However, I cannot guarantee it will be fast, improvements have been made to our internet infrastructure.

**TOPICS WILL BE ANNOUNCED IN THE BALLROOM, ALL BALLOTS MUST BE PICKED UP BEFORE THE TOPIC IS ANNOUNCED, COMPETITORS WILL HAVE 20 MINUTES FOR ALL ROUNDS. 15 MINUTES PREP ; ALL OTHER TIME SHOULD BE USED TO GET TO ROOMS.**
