A Bill to Restrict AI Voice Cloning Without Consent

- 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
- 2. Section 1 No company or individual may create or distribute an
- 3. AI-generated voice clone of a person without their consent.
- 4. Section 2 AI-generated voice clone means any artificial recording
- 5. that imitates a real person's voice using computer software.
- 6. Section 3 The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) will enforce this law.
- 7. Anyone who creates or uses a voice clone without consent will be
- 8. fined \$25,000 per violation.
- 9. Section 4 his legislation will take effect on July 1, 2026.
- 10. Section 5 All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
- 11. declared null and void.
