- 3. wear safety helmets.
- 4. Section 2 Electric scooters are defined as small two-wheeled
- 5. vehicles powered by an electric motor, often used for
- 6. short-distance travel in cities.
- 7. Section 3 Local police departments will enforce this law. Riders
- 8. found without helmets will be fined \$50.
- 9. Section 4 This legislation will take effect on July 1, 2026.
- 10. Section 5 All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
- 11. declared null and void.
