

**A Bill to Restrict Data Tracking in Mobile
AppsUntitled Bill**

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2. **Section 1** Mobile apps shall be prohibited from tracking user

3. location or behavior unless the user gives clear permission each

4. time the app is opened.

5. **Section 2** Data tracking includes collecting GPS location, browsing

6. activity within the app, and information about other apps

7. installed on the device.

8. **Section 3** The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) will enforce this law.

9. Companies that violate it will face fines of up to \$50,000 per

10. incident.

11. **Section 4** This legislation will take effect on July 1, 2026.

12. **Section 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby

13. declared null and void.

6. to health concerns; and
7. **WHEREAS**, Removing synthetic dyes would encourage companies to use
8. safer natural coloring alternatives; now, therefore, be it
9. **RESOLVED**, That the Congress here assembled support limiting the use
10. of synthetic food dyes in processed foods sold in the United
11. States.
