

A Bill to Limit the Size of Sugary Drinks

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
2. **Section 1** Restaurants and movie theaters may not sell sugary drinks
3. larger than 20 ounces in a single cup.
4. **Section 2** Sugary drinks include sodas, sweetened teas, lemonades,
5. and sports drinks with added sugar.
6. **Section 3** The Food and Drug Administration will enforce this law.
7. Businesses that violate the size limit will be fined \$300 per
8. violation.
9. **Section 4** This legislation will take effect on July 1, 2026.
10. **Section 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
11. declared null and void.

A Resolution to Restrict Loud Gas-Powered Boats on Lakes

1. **WHEREAS**, Gas-powered boats can create loud noise that disturbs
2. people and wildlife on lakes; and
3. **WHEREAS**, Excessive noise can disrupt fishing, swimming, and outdoor
4. recreation; and
5. **WHEREAS**, Quieter electric and low-noise boats are becoming more
6. common and affordable; and
7. **WHEREAS**, Many lake communities have requested stronger noise
8. protections; now, therefore, be it
9. **RESOLVED**, That the Congress here assembled encourage limits on the
10. use of loud gas-powered boats on public lakes in the United
11. States.

A Bill to Ban Food Packaging with Cartoon Characters

1. **WHEREAS**, Food packaging that uses cartoon characters to advertise
2. products high in sugar, salt, or fat shall be prohibited.
3. **WHEREAS**, This restriction applies to cereals, snacks, candy, and
4. drinks marketed primarily to children.
5. **WHEREAS**, The Federal Trade Commission will enforce this law.
6. Companies that violate the ban will be fined \$10,000 per product.
7. **WHEREAS**, This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2027.
8. **RESOLVED**, All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
9. declared null and void.
