A Bill to Require Cash Payment Options at Large Events

1. **WHEREAS**, Large public events in the United States shall be required
2. to accept cash as a form of payment for food, merchandise, and
3. services.
4. **WHEREAS**, Large public events include concerts, festivals, sporting
5. events, and fairs that host more than 5,000 attendees in a single
6. day.
7. **WHEREAS**, The Department of Commerce will oversee enforcement of
8. this requirement. Event organizers that refuse to accept cash
9. will be fined \$10,000 per day of noncompliance.
10. **WHEREAS**, This legislation will take effect on July 1, 2026.
11. **RESOLVED**, All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
12. declared null and void.

3. **WHEREAS**, These filters can contribute to body image issues and
4. lowered self-esteem among teenagers; and
5. **WHEREAS**, Social media companies profit from increased engagement
6. driven by filtered content; and
7. **WHEREAS**, Users should be able to express themselves without harmful
8. pressure to alter their appearance; now, therefore, be it
9. **RESOLVED**, That the Congress here assembled encourage limits on the
10. use of appearance-altering facial filters on social media
11. platforms.
