

A Bill to Ban Gas-Powered Lawn Equipment

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2. **Section 1** The sale of new gas-powered leaf blowers, lawn mowers,
3. and trimmers shall be prohibited in the United States.

4. **Section 2** All lawn care equipment sold after this law takes effect
5. must be electric or battery-powered.

6. **Section 3** The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will enforce
7. this law. Violations will result in a \$2,000 fine per sale.

8. **Section 4** This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2027.

9. **Section 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
10. declared null and void.

A Bill to Require Warning Labels on Video Games with Online Chat

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2. **Section 1** All video games that include online chat features must

3. have a visible warning label informing players that online

4. interactions may expose them to bullying or inappropriate content.

5. **Section 2** The Entertainment Software Rating Board (ESRB) will

6. ensure that all affected games display the warning on the box,

7. startup screen, or download page.

8. **Section 3** The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) will enforce this law.

9. Game publishers who fail to display proper warnings will be fined

10. \$10,000 per title.

11. **Section 4** This legislation will take effect on July 1, 2026.

12. **Section 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby

13. declared null and void.

A Resolution to Ban Zoos That Do Not Meet Animal Welfare Standards

1. **WHEREAS**, Some zoos keep animals in small cages or poor conditions
2. that do not meet their physical or mental needs; and
3. **WHEREAS**, These conditions can cause suffering and unnatural
4. behavior in wild animals; and
5. **WHEREAS**, Well-managed wildlife sanctuaries and nature reserves can
6. educate the public without cruelty; and
7. **WHEREAS**, Many countries have already banned or restricted zoos with
8. low welfare standards; now, therefore, be it
9. **RESOLVED**, That the Congress here assembled support a ban on zoos
10. that do not meet federal animal welfare standards established by
11. the U.S. Department of Agriculture.
