Judging Information:

- One I.E. judge covers five slots per pattern.
- One IPDA judge covers two debaters.
- Uncovered slots will not be allowed.
- Novice only and Junior only judges are not permitted. All judges are expected to be ready to judge Open competition.
- Schools must bring separate judges for IPDA and IE events. We reserve the right to limit IPDA entry if necessary.

Entry Procedure: Entries must be sent by using the forensicstournament.net website: http://www.forensicstournament.net. There is no separate division for novices. All competitors will compete in a single open division. Entries must be completed by 5pm on Tuesday, November 5th. Drop Fees: A \$5 drop fee will be assessed after 5PM Tuesday, November 5th.

Events and Rules:

- 11 Individual events will be offered in open division only. A.F.A. Event Descriptions will apply. We will use A.F.A. style for impromptu.
- Students may enter a maximum of two events per pattern.
- Students may not enter both IPDA and IE's. You must choose one or the other.
- In conjunction with the rules of the Griffin Invitational, no material used in competition shall have been used by the student in intercollegiate competition prior to September 1, 2023.
- If Palomar students compete at the tournament, they will not be eligible for sweepstakes awards or points.
