BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

Section 1. All domestic physical and online nurseries selling cacti native to the United States are required to apply for FWS form 3-200-55 at the cost of \$200 for each business.

A. At brick and mortar nurseries, the approved FWS permit must be physically displayed.

B. Online nurseries must provide a copy of their approved FWS permit on each sale delivered.

Section 2. All international trade and sale of cacti native to the United States is prohibited.

Section 3. The US Department of the Interior will oversee the enforcement of this bill.

A. Domestic violators of this legislation shall be subject to a ban on sale and growing of native cacti for 10 years and fines starting at \$10,000.

B. Domestic growers caught selling internationally shall be subject to a ban on sale and growing of native cacti for 15 years and fines starting at \$25,000.

C. 50% of each application fee and monies collected in penalties will be used to fund research and rehabilitation of cacti native to the United States.

SECTION 4. This shall take effect on February 14, 2020.

Section 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

## A Bill To Aid Japan As Part Of The U.S.-Japan Mutual Security Treaty

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

4 the United States and Japan.

5 **SECTION 2.** This applies to The Military.

7 and implementation of this bill.

8 **SECTION 4.** This bill will go into effect in January 1, 2021.

9 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null

13 **SECTION 4.** This bill shall take effect on July 1, 2020.

14 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null  
15 and void.

# A Bill to Release All Non-Violent Drug Offenders from Prison

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** Non-Violent Drug Offenders should be released from Prison.

3 A. The United States has the highest prison population in  
4 the world, ranging from serious crimes to minor offenses, and  
5 drug offenses count for 20% of the people in incarceration, or half  
6 a million people.

7 B. These arrests continue to affect these offenders'  
8 employment prospects, and possibly longer sentences for future  
9 offenses.

10 **SECTION 2.** Non-violent drug offenders apply to drug offenders that didn't  
11 commit charges regarding murder, assault, or cause others severe  
12 trauma that will lead to constant flashbacks, immediate need of  
13 therapy, etc.

14 **SECTION 3.** The Federal Bureau of Prisons shall oversee the enforcement and  
15 implementation of this bill.

16 **SECTION 4.** This bill will go into effect on January 1, 2020.

17 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null  
18 and void.
