

A Bill to Grant Citizenship to All Illegal Immigrants Who Serve in the U.S. Military

- 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:
- 2 **SECTION 1**. Citizenship will be granted to any illegal immigrant that serves a two year
- term in the United States Military without being dishonorably discharged.
- 4 **SECTION 2**. Citizenship will be defined as full rights of a United States citizen.
- Dishonorable discharge will be defined as the dismissal of someone from
- the armed forces as a result of criminal or morally unacceptable actions
- 7 as defined by military tribunals.
- 8 **SECTION 3.** The U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Service will oversee the
- 9 administration of citizenships.
- SECTION 4. This bill will be effective immediately and offered to all illegals currently
- enrolled in the armed forces.
- SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
