



A Bill to Grant Citizenship to All Illegal Immigrants Who Serve in the U.S. Military

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** Citizenship will be granted to any illegal immigrant that serves a two year
3 term in the United States Military without being dishonorably discharged.

4 **SECTION 2.** Citizenship will be defined as full rights of a United States citizen.

5 Dishonorable discharge will be defined as the dismissal of someone from
6 the armed forces as a result of criminal or morally unacceptable actions
7 as defined by military tribunals.

8 **SECTION 3.** The U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Service will oversee the
9 administration of citizenships.

10 **SECTION 4.** This bill will be effective immediately and offered to all illegals currently
11 enrolled in the armed forces.

12 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
