

A Bill to Abolish Guns

1 **Be it enacted by this Congress that:**

2 **Section 1.** The United States should abolish guns.

3 **Section 2.** Abolish means to destroy the guns people already have and to stop the gun making  
4 companies from making guns. A gun is defined as a weapon using a metal tube that propels  
5 bullets in an explosive force.

6 **Section 3.** The ATF would oversee this bill.

7 **Section 4.** This bill will be passed on January 1st, 2019.

8 **Section 5.** All other laws in conflict with this new policy shall hereby be declared will and  
9 using.

A Bill to Abolish Zoos

1 **Be it enacted by this Congress that:**

2 **Section 1:** The U.S. should abolish all zoos.

3 **Section 2:** A zoo is defined as an establishment that maintains a collection of wild animals,  
4 typically in park or gardens, for study, conservation, or display to the public.

5 **Section 3:** This bill will be overseen by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service.

6 **Section 4:** This bill will take effect on January 1, 2025.

7 **Section 5:** All other laws in conflict with this new policy shall hereby be declared null and void.

A Bill to Remove Uniforms in Public Schools

1 **Be it enacted by this Congress that:**

2 **Section 1:** No public schools should require uniforms.

3 **Section 2:** Public School should be defined as K-12 schools that receive federal money.

4 **Section 3:** The Department of Education shall oversee this bill.

5 **Section 4:** This bill shall be put in action in the 2019-2020 school year.

6 **Section 5:** All other laws in conflict with this new policy hereby be declared null and void.

A Bill to Provide More Public Restrooms

1 **Be it enacted by this Congress that:**

2 **Section 1:** The US should build more public restrooms.

3 **Section 2:** Public restroom are defined as free restrooms in public spaces.

4 “More” is defined as for every 55 homeless people, one more public restroom should be added.

5 **Section 3:** The enforcement of this bill should be overseen by the Department of Housing and  
6 Urban Development.

7 **Section 4:** The construction of the public restrooms should be started by July 1st 2021 and  
8 should take no more than 7 years.

9 **Section 5:** All other laws in conflict with this new policy shall hereby be declared null and void.
