



## **PCC Winter Invitational February 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup>**

**Hi Colleagues,**

On behalf of the Pasadena City College forensics team and staff, we would like to invite you and your team to the 1<sup>st</sup> ever PCC Winter Invitational – February 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> (Fri-Sat), 2019. We are thoughtfully avoiding Super Bowl Sunday for your convenience.

At the PCC WI, your students will be able to compete in:

- Novice and Open Divisions of IPDA and NFA-LD on Friday, February 1
- Novice and Open Divisions of Parliamentary Debate and on Saturday, February 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- Novice and Open Divisions of 11 Individual Events on Saturday, February 2<sup>nd</sup>.

**All entries are due by 6:00pm on Tuesday, January 29<sup>th</sup>. We will use forensicstournament.net. You can still make changes to your entry online until 6:00pm on Thursday, January 31<sup>st</sup>. Drop fees will be assessed after the Thursday deadline.**

### **Noteworthy Details**

1. Students cannot be double-entered in IPDA and NFA-LD
2. Students cannot be double-entered in NPDA and IEs
3. Open contestants may triple enter in individual events at their own risk.
4. Novice contestants may double enter in individual events.
5. AFA event descriptions will apply
6. We will use AFA style for impromptu
7. We will offer 4 prelims of IPDA, NFA-LD and Parli. All three will have Phi Rho Pi elim rounds
8. FLEX TIME has been added to Parliamentary Debate as of the 2018 Coaches Conference. Flex time may be used by the controlling team to prepare arguments, drink water, set up stands, ask questions of their opponents, etc. Flex time may not be used as additional speech time.
9. Prep rooms will be made available for NPDA but not IPDA.
10. There will be two prelim rounds of individual events, with one final round for each individual event pattern.
11. We feed the judges pretty well throughout the entire day and you can watch programs on the big screen in the theater.

Pattern A – Extemp, Informative, STE, Prose, Poetry

Pattern B – Impromptu, Persuasive, CA, Drama, POI, DUO

## **Parking**

## **Eligibility**

Novice: For both individual events and Parliamentary Debate, a student is eligible for the Novice Division if she or he has not placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in the event (semi-final in debate) or a like event two or more times and has not competed for more than two semesters.

No speech shall have been presented by that student in **any** competition prior to August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018.

## **Judging Guidelines**

- A school may not utilize novice and junior only judges in a greater proportion than its novice and/or junior entry warrants.
- Failure of a judge to appear for a ballot in the debate events will result in the forced withdrawal of those entries covered by that judge.
- Judges must remain at the tournament one round beyond the elimination of their last participant. (All judges are committed to judge the first elimination round).
- Please pick up your ballots 15 minutes before the round.

## **Judging Commitments**

Debate Commitment: All schools must provide one judge for every two (2) team or IPDA/LD debate entries or fraction thereof. **UNCOVERED SLOTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED FOR DEBATE** (except at the discretion of the Tournament Director).

Individual Events Commitment: All schools must provide one judge for every five individual event slots per conflict pattern or fraction thereof.

IPDA Judging: The by-laws of IPDA recommend lay judges to help foster the spirit of a public debate where technical knowledge is not needed. With this in mind, non-experienced judges will be utilized in IPDA when possible. Please consider bringing non-specialized judges to cover your IPDA entry.

## **Judging Fees**

Schools not meeting their judging commitment will be assessed the following fees:

- IE slots uncovered - \$20 per slot

- NFA-LD/IPDA debate judges - \$40 per entry (if allowed\*)
  - Team Debate judges - \$80 per team (if allowed\*)
- \* Contact the tournament director for approval

**Awards:**

1. The top six competitors in each individual event will advance to finals and receive trophies.
2. Debate will break to bronze and gold elimination rounds. Teams not advancing Elimination Round 1 will receive bronze medals. Teams in Elimination Round 2 will win either silver or gold medals.
3. Awards will be presented to the top five speakers in each division of debate.
4. Sweepstakes awards will be presented to the top two year-schools and the top four-year school in competition. The host school is ineligible for sweepstakes. The following point system will be used.

**Sweepstakes points:**

Individual events:

- 1st place: 5 points
- 2nd place: 4 points
- 3rd place: 3 points
- Finalist: 2 points

Debate:

- Gold: 10 points
- Silver: 6 points
- Bronze: 4 points
