On behalf of Sentinel, Big Sky, and Hellgate High Schools, we invite you to the Garden City Regional Tournament on November 9-10, 2018 in Missoula. We will allow teams to bring up to 16 JV entries to help students gain valuable tournament experience.

**Entry Deadline:** Initial online registration is due Friday, November 2nd by 4:00 PM. *Final* registration is due by 7:00pm, Tuesday, November 6th. Register online at <https://forensicstournament.net/gardencityregional/18>. Changes after the website closes must be made via email to [clbrooks@mcpsmt.org](mailto:clbrooks@mcpsmt.org). Codes and tabbing assignments will be sent via email. There will be no on-site registration. Timely registration is appreciated in order to guarantee the correct number of judges.

**Entry Limit:** Entries for Varsity teams will be limited to 4 individuals/teams in each event, with 42 entries overall. Teams will be allowed to bring up to 16 JV entries, distributed across any events (no more than 4 JV entries per event please). Please register a separate JV team on [forensicstournament.net](http://forensicstournament.net).

**Events:** All AA events will be offered including POI. POI entries may be placed on either the Varsity or JV roster and will be factored into overall sweepstakes points. We ask that all “ABC” entries use the “AA” rules in all events.

**Fees:** Each team will be charged a \$10 team fee and each entry will be charged a \$5 entry fee. There will be no charges for drops/adds, but please be timely with changes so that we book the correct number of judges.

**Locations:** All events will be held at Sentinel High School.

**Concessions:** Full concessions will be available.

**Novice:** Novice debate will be offered in both LD and POL.

**Octafinals:** No octafinals will be offered in any event.

**Rules:** All events will follow the MHSA handbook. Comment sheets may be printed on letter-sized paper. If there are extra judges in Speech, they may be used as dummy judges, assigned to panels, or used as drop judges in semifinals or finals.

**Awards:** Awards will be held in the Sentinel High School main gym *immediately* following the final round of debate.
