Each school will be charged an entry fee of \$5.00/participant, plus an additional \$35.00/school fee to offset the costs of the state program. Please have your final registration completed by **Wednesday, Jan. 16th, 4:00 PM**.

**Program:** I will share the state program with you so that you can update your school, coach, and competitor information. If I do not have one for you, please send me a valid gmail account. I need to send the booklet to printing by the afternoon of **Thursday**, **Jan. 17**, so please make sure your info and entries are accurate by then. List all of the coaches you'd like included in the program, but please let me know which coaches will actually be attending, as well as their tabbing preferences, via email as soon as possible.
