**Divisions:** We will offer novice and open divisions for all IE events. Novice events with less than 5 entries will be collapsed into an open division.

Novice – Students in the novice division must be undergraduate students in their first four semesters of collegiate forensics, that have not placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place in a final round in that genre of event.

Open – Students in the open division must be undergraduate students with eight or fewer semesters of intercollegiate forensics experience who have not completed a bachelor's degree.

**Entries:** Students may triple-enter within either IE pattern of competition. Students are responsible for getting to all rounds on time. Students in Extemp should do that event prior to doing their other event(s).

Pattern A: CA, Duo, Impromptu, Informative, Poetry

Pattern B: ADS, DI, Extemp, Persuasion, POI, Prose

**Awards**: Certificates (or something similarly awesome) will be awarded to all IE finalists. Handmade sweepstakes awards will be given to the top three teams.

**Sweepstakes:** 

1st - 10 pts.

2nd - 8 pts.

3rd - 6 pts.

Finalist IEs: 4 pts.

**Judging Requirements:** As a free tournament that is trying to make a comeback we need schools to cover their entries. We will also be hiring judges, if you know anyone that would like to sign up as a paid judge please have them contact me. One judge covers five IE slots in each pattern. Each uncovered slot will incur a \$25 fee.

**Entry Fees:** Gratis!
