FIREWORKS IN LINCOLN CITY

Possession of illegal fireworks is a class B misdemeanor and can result in a <u>fine of up to \$2,500</u> <u>and up to 6 months in jail</u>. You may also be liable for injuries or property damage.

City ordinances prohibit the sale, possession, and use of fireworks in the City of Lincoln City. Specifically, in City Parks, Parking Lots, and on City Streets and Rights of Way, the use of <u>any</u> <u>type of firework, including exempt fireworks, such as; sparklers, snakes, model rockets, rocket</u> <u>motors, other form of explosive, or smoke-producing device or instrument</u>, is prohibited and carries a minimum \$250.00 fine.

The use of fireworks is **prohibited at Oregon State beaches**, **parks**, **campgrounds**, **and State and Federal forest lands** as defined by the office of the Oregon State Fire Marshall. Exempt fireworks, as defined in ORS 480.111, are permitted <u>only on private property</u>.
