
Tonto National Monument

In 2022, 31.5 thousand park visitors spent an estimated \$2.1 million in local gateway regions while visiting Tonto National Monument. These expenditures supported a total of 29 jobs, \$1.1 million in labor income, \$1.9 million in value added, and \$3.2 million in economic output in local gateway economies surrounding Tonto National Monumer


