RULES & GUIDELINES

1. [Local](#) and [State Rules](#) govern this competition.
2. Exhibitors are responsible for reading and abiding by the guidelines stated herein.
3. If you need assistance determining the division and/or class, please contact the Exhibits Office at 714-708-1553 or email hobbiesandhandcrafts@ocfair.com.
4. **Causes for disqualification.** Disqualified entries will not be displayed and must be picked up when notified.
 - Non-compliance to the competition and OC Fair guidelines will result in disqualification.
 - Entries over the maximum amount will not be accepted.
 - Articles showing signs of wear or use may be disqualified.
 - Entries must follow the rules of the division and class.
 - Items previously shown in the OC Fair will be disqualified.
 - Work must be finished; no incomplete or work-in-progress will be accepted.
5. **Entry fees are non-refundable.** There will be no refunds for any reason. By entering the competition, the exhibitor is accepting the no-refund policy.
6. Adult Fiber Arts is a juried competition. Not all entries will be accepted.
7. All youth entries are accepted if rules are followed.
8. All entries must have been completed within the last two (2) years.
9. **A photo upload of each entry is required. If a photo is not received, the entry will not be accepted.**
 - Excludes Knots of Love and Quits of Valor.
10. The display and location of entry are at the discretion of the program coordinator. No entry will be accepted where an exhibitor describes the conditions under which they will exhibit or how the entry must be displayed.
11. Exhibitors are responsible for entering their items in the correct division and class.
12. Final acceptance of the entry will be left to the discretion of the program coordinator.
13. Due to the family-oriented theme of OC Fair, work dealing with drug use, obscenity, defamatory statements, violence, gang activity, offensive or objectionable content will not be accepted. This is at the discretion of OC Fair staff.
14. **Hold harmless.** Although reasonable efforts will be taken to safeguard exhibitors' property against loss, damage or theft, neither the State of California nor OC Fair & Event Center will be responsible for any loss, damage or theft of exhibitors' property brought on the premises during the period of OC Fair.
15. Entries not picked up on entry pick up day become the property of OC Fair and will be disposed of promptly.



ELIGIBILITY

Adult divisions:

Open to Southern California residents ages 18 and older.
Special interest divisions are open to all adult U.S. residents.

Youth divisions:

Open to youth ages 5-17 (by July 17) who live in Southern California.

ENTRY LIMIT

Adult divisionsFive (5) fiber art entries per exhibitor

Youth divisionsThree (3) fiber art entries per exhibitor

- Sets or ensembles may be entered as one (1) entry.
- Quilts and afghans are limited to one (1) each.

ENTRY FEES

Adult divisions\$10 per entry

Youth divisions (9-17).....\$6 per entry

Ages (5-8).....Free

- Entry fees are payable online with a credit card (Visa, Mastercard or American Express).
- *No refunds will be issued.*

OC FAIR EXHIBITOR TICKET

Exhibitors will receive one (1) OC Fair admission ticket at time of entry delivery.

If none of an exhibitor's entries are accepted for exhibition, one (1) free admission ticket will be mailed to you.

- One (1) ticket per exhibitor, not per entry.
- Ticket is good any day of the OC Fair and does not require a reservation.
- Tickets are provided to participants to view the results of their efforts.
- Tickets must not be sold.

PHOTOGRAPHING YOUR WORK FOR ENTRY

Digital photo submission of your entry is required except for Knots of Love and Quilts of Valor.



- Photo upload is limited to one per entry.

Image format

- JPEG, JPG or PNG file formats.
- iPhone users must change the default HEIC camera setting to JPEG or convert the image.
- RGB color space (CMYK files will be converted to RGB by the system).
- Be sure that the image is rotated to be in an upright position and orientation.
- Maximum file size: 8 MB (megabytes).



Step 1. Register

- Last year's accounts are no longer valid. All exhibitors must create a new account.
- Entries must be submitted under the name of the individual who will be exhibiting.
- Do not use business or fictitious names.
- There are no team entries.
- Enter the information carefully and proofread the name, title and description of the entry for punctuation, capitalization and spelling to ensure accuracy on exhibit display labels.
- Descriptions are limited to 100 characters and should include a short statement about the work or the methods and techniques used.
- Email will be used to send important information. Check your spam folders and whitelist emails coming from @ocfair.com.

Step 2. Entries

- Input your entry (or entries) in the proper department, division and class along with other required information.

Step 3. Cart review

- Review your entries. You can add, edit, delete or save your entries.
- When satisfied, click the "CHECK OUT" button.

Step 4. Payment

- Enter your credit card information (Mastercard, Visa or American Express).
- An email notification and confirmation will be sent immediately after the online payment is received.
- Check your spam folder if the email confirmation does not arrive shortly after submitting payment.

Step 5. Confirmation

- Sign by typing "YES" in the "Agreement to Terms" box.
- DO NOT click the "SUBMIT" button multiple times as you will be charged.
- On the resulting confirmation page, you can print a receipt. A blue "UPLOAD FILES" button will also appear.

Step 6. Image upload

- Click on the "UPLOAD FILES" button to start uploading your images into the system.

You can log back into your account to see your entry (or entries) and replace images and descriptions. For any other changes, contact us: entries@ocfair.com. Do not re-enter to make corrections as you will be charged.

Pricing

Entries may be marked NFS (not for sale) or for sale by indicating the selling price \$_____.

Prospective Buyers

No sale or acceptance of fees for items will be made by OC Fair. Prospective buyers may fill out an *Interested in Purchasing Exhibited Art* form that will be forwarded to the exhibitor at the close of OC Fair. The OC Fair does not take commission on items sold as a result of exhibition in the Hobbies & Handcrafts Competition.

JUDGES

Qualified judges are utilized to judge all exhibits and special contests. Judges are selected from local professionals and individuals who are experienced and highly qualified in their fields. Each year, the program coordinator may choose new judges or judges may judge different divisions. The judges' decisions are final.

Reassignment of entry division or class

Judges and/or the program coordinator have the option of reassigning an entry to a more appropriate division or class or combining divisions or classes to create an adequate judging pool. Nevertheless, it is the responsibility of exhibitors to enter work in the appropriate class. Failure to enter the appropriate class may result in disqualification.

FIRST-ROUND ONLINE JUDGING

Adult divisions will be judged first from your uploaded images to determine if the submitted entry meets the basic requirements for participation in this competition, is entered in the most correct or appropriate category and meets the subjective standards for the exhibition set by the judges.

Exhibitor will be notified by email with the results of the first-round judging.

An email will be sent for each entry. Please check your spam/junk folder. The email will come from sweb@fairsoftware.com. Results may also be viewed online at ocfair.com/results.

Acceptance for exhibition

Only accepted work should be delivered on the entry delivery day. First-round judging acceptance does not guarantee acceptance for exhibition. The delivered entry may still be judged out for not complying with the competition rules and guidelines.

- Not all entries will be accepted. Due to the high number of entries and limited display space, OC Fair cannot accept all the work submitted.



ENTRY DELIVERY



Delivery date: Friday & Saturday, June 19-20, 10 a.m. - 4 p.m.

- One participation ribbon will be given to each exhibitor on entry delivery day.
- Late deliveries will not be accepted.
- Entries may be delivered by someone other than the exhibitor.

Entry delivery

- Enter Gate 1 and follow the marked route.
- Drop off is located on the east side of the Hobbies & Handcrafts Gallery/Anaheim Building (building 4 on the map).
- Email alerts will be sent prior to the delivery date with detailed information. Check your spam folder for emails.



Claim checks

- Will be provided when exhibits are delivered.
- Are required to pick up your entry on entry pick up day.
- Entries may be picked up by someone other than the exhibitor.

ENTRY PICK UP

Pick up date: Thursday, Aug. 20, 10 a.m. - 6 p.m.

- An email alert will be sent prior to the pick up date with detailed information. Check your spam folder for emails.
- Claim check or photo ID is required for pick up.
- If you are unable to pick up your items, please arrange for someone to pick them up for you.
- Unclaimed items and ribbons become the property of OC Fair and will be discarded.

Entry pick up

- Pick up entries at the Hobbies & Handcrafts Gallery/Anaheim Building (building 4 on the map).
- Enter through Gate 1 (Main Gate) and follow the directional signs.



AWARD JUDGING

Adult divisions

Entries are placed using the American Judging System, where exhibits are ranked one against another.

- First, second, third place and honorable mention may be awarded in each class if judges so determine. More than one honorable mention per class may be awarded.
- First place winners will compete for "Division Winner."
- Division Winners will compete for "Best of Show."

Youth divisions

Entries are placed using the Danish Judging System, where each entry is judged on how well it meets a standard rather than how it compares to other entries.

- Entries are judged first, second or third place.
- There may be more than one first, second or third place award per class.
- All first place awards will then compete using the American Judging System, for "Division Winner."
- Those chosen for Division Winner will compete for "Best of Show" when there are two (2) or more divisions represented in the show.

Blue Ribbon Kids

- All Blue Ribbon Kids (ages 5-8) receive a special ribbon. The entries are not judged and are not eligible for cash awards.

Reassignment of entry division or class

Judges and/or the program coordinator have the option of reassigning an entry to a more appropriate division or class or combining divisions or classes to create an adequate judging pool.

Judging criteria

- **Adult:** Entries are judged on originality and creativity, workmanship and technique, level of difficulty, color and design, finishing/framing and visual impact.
- **Youth:** Entries are judged on appearance, workmanship, creativity/originality and an overall score.

Judges' Award

Additional awards may be made at the discretion of each judge for outstanding entries that exhibit special qualities that the judges feel deserve to be recognized.

Industry awards

Awarded by a community guild or organization.

Theme Award

Awarded to an entry that best represents the annual OC Fair Theme.

Disqualified entries

If an entry is disqualified after judging is complete, the judge will not change the status of awards given for other entries. Judges reserve the right to remove or disqualify any entry in violation of the rules, in poor taste or not in accordance with the competition standards.

- Exhibitors will receive awarded ribbons on entry pick up day.
- Award checks will be made payable to the exhibitor whose name is indicated on the entry form and mailed within 30 business days after the close of the 2026 OC Fair.
- Total premiums of \$600 or more to any individual will be paid only after a completed *Payee Data Record* form has been received.

Judging results

- All accepted entries will be displayed in the Hobbies & Handcrafts Gallery with any awards received.
- Results will be posted online around the second week of OC Fair at ocfair.com/results.
- ***Please do not call, email or message OC Fair via social media for competition results. We receive a high volume of inquiries daily.***

AWARDS CEREMONY

Sunday, Aug. 16, at noon.

- Hosted on the OC Promenade Main Stage.
- Best of Show award recipients will be invited, given two (2) tickets to attend and recognized at the ceremony.
- Invitations will be sent to the email provided at entry registration.
- All exhibitors and the general public are welcome to attend the ceremony.





HOW TO PREPARE

Framed items

- **Maximum size is 36-by-36 inches.**
- Framed items to be hung must be wired and ready to hang.
- Improperly wired entries will not be hung.
- No sawtooth hangers, masking tape, string, pop-top rings, etc.
- Framing with plastic or plexiglass is preferred.
- OC Fair staff will use extreme care in handling frames containing glass but assume no responsibility for breakage.

Sets or ensembles

May be entered as one entry. Exhibitor must label each piece in a set: "1 of 2," "2 of 2," etc.

Finishing work

Must be done by the exhibitor except blocking, framing and pillow construction, which may be done by a professional. Please note on entry form.

BED QUILTS – HOW TO PREPARE

Info card

Include with accepted entry a 3-by-5-inch info card with the following information:

- Source of design pattern name.
- Dimensions of quilt (length and width).
- Date of completion.
- If it is hand quilted.

Entry limit

- One (1) bed quilt per exhibitor due to the popularity of the quilt competition and limited display space.
- Entire quilt may not be displayed due to space limitations.

How to categorize

- To qualify for a class, more than 50 percent of the construction and techniques in the entered class must be used.
- “Mixed Techniques” means that two (2) or more techniques are used where the additional techniques are more than embellishment, e.g., sampler quilts.
- When a quilt top has been professionally/commercially machine quilted by another person, it must be entered into Division 472: Quilt Top by Exhibitor, Quilting by Another.
- Quilting must go through all layers of fabric.
- Quilts made by groups (two [2] or more persons) must be entered into group quilts. Include names of all parties involved in the description.

Hanging materials

Please include a 4-inch sleeve (rod pocket attached to backing of quilt) for hanging. The sleeve is not required and is not included in the judging.


