RULES

- 1. Local and state rules govern this competition.
- 2. Exhibitors are responsible for reading the competition guidelines and relevant supporting documents and must abide by them. There may be changes from the previous year. Relevant documents include:
 - Horticulture Judging Criteria
 - Horticulture Glossary and FAQ
 - How to Prepare Your Container Plant
- **3. Note that this page provides only broad guidelines for this competition.** More specific information is spread throughout pertinent sections in this guide.
- 4. Size limits are strictly enforced.
 - No entry may exceed 50 lbs; all items must be movable by staff.
 - Hanging entries may not exceed two (2) feet as measured from their mounting to the lowest point of the
 item (plant or container), and must include a secure hanger provided by the exhibitor. Wall-mounted
 entries will not be accepted.
- **5. Entries shall not contain materials that may rot or cause unpleasant odors** (e.g., asphalt, fresh compost, burned items, cooked food).
- **6.** Highly complex setups, particularly those containing many unconnected pieces, are strongly discouraged. Excessive **entries may not be accepted.** Consider that individual staff may be required to move your entries for final exhibit placement.
- 7. Small items should be securely fastened to their containers. Items of great or sentimental value should not be used.
- 8. All plants should come in clean containers and be well-established as evidenced by being firmly rooted (exceptions: air plants and plants grown hydroponically).
- 9. Entries incorrectly identified, or those which do not match their labels, will be disqualified.
- **10.** OC Fair reserves the right to refuse to accept or disqualify and remove from exhibit any entry considered ineligible for competition (e.g., entries with serious disease or insect problems, under quarantine as specified under the California Department of Food and Agriculture or endangers the staff and/or public).
- 11. Although reasonable efforts will be undertaken to safeguard exhibitors' property, neither the State of California nor OC Fair & Event Center will be responsible for any loss, damage or theft of exhibitors' property brought on the premises during the OC Fair. Every precaution will be taken in the handling and exhibiting of entries.

ELIGIBILITY

Adult Divisions: Open to California residents, ages 18 or older.

Youth Divisions: Open to youth ages 6-17 (by July 18) who live in California.

ENTRY LIMIT

- Entering in multiple Divisions and Classes is allowed. Multiple entries per Class is not allowed.
- The same item cannot be re-entered in subsequent competitions, neither under the original nor a different exhibitor's name.

If multiple entries are submitted by the same exhibitor in the same Class, they will be disqualified.

HOW TO ENTER

- Go to <u>ocgard.fairwire.com</u> to submit your entries online by the registration deadline listed on the front cover of this guide. **PLEASE NOTE: all exhibitors must create a new account; last year's accounts are no longer valid.**
- For detailed information on the online entry process, consult the Entry Tutorial.

Exhibitor Name

- Provide the most complete information possible for each entry (e.g., species/cultivar if known).
- Entries must be made under the name of the individual who prepared it (this also applies to youth entries). Do not use team, business or fictitious names.
- All information will be displayed as entered. Please carefully proofread for punctuation, capitalization and spelling. Fair Management is not responsible for errors on entry forms. Severe errors may lead to disqualification.

Entry Confirmation

An email notification and confirmation will be sent immediately after your online payment is received. **PLEASE NOTE:** this email will not be sent if you do not click the final "finish" button.

Late entries will not be accepted.

- Enter Gate 1 off of Fair Drive and park in Lot B (in front of Centennial Farm).
- Check-in tables will be located at the Centennial Farm gate for you to pick up your entry tags, tickets and/or ribbons. All exhibitors must check in and enter through the Farm gate.
- Exhibitors will not be admitted to the Farm before 7 a.m. and must be checked in and inside the Farm gate by 9:30 a.m. Entries may be delivered by someone other than the exhibitor.

Please bring other individuals or tools, like wagons, if you need assistance transporting your entries, especially if large in size or quantity. Centennial Farm has a few push carts available for exhibitor use on a first-come, first served basis, but we cannot guarantee assistance. If you are unsure what is appropriate to enter or what you are allowed to bring to transport your item(s), please contact us before delivery day to confirm.

OC FAIR TICKET

Exhibitors will receive one (1) 2025 OC Fair admission ticket at the time of entry delivery to ensure they can view the results of their efforts on display.

- One (1) ticket per exhibitor, not per entry.
- Tickets are good any day during the OC Fair and do not require reservations. Tickets must not be re-sold.

ENTRY DISPLAY

After judging, entries will be displayed for one (1) Fair week at Centennial Farm. Images of ribbons will be printed on the entry tags to identify awards given.

Items will be discarded if they deteriorate. There are no guarantees that an entry will be displayed.

ENTRY PICK UP

Entry pick up dates are listed on the front page of this guide.

Final entry pick up: Tuesday, Aug. 19

If you are unable to pick up your item(s), please arrange for someone to pick them up for you. Unclaimed items and ribbons become the property of OC Fair and will be discarded. **We will not provide reminders via phone call or email.**

OC Fair & Event Center is not responsible for exhibits or ribbons left after the final entry pick up date.

JUDGING

Qualified judges will be selected by the program coordinator. The program coordinator may choose new judges each year, or judges may judge different Divisions from year to year. The judges are professionals and their decisions are final.

Judging is not open to the public. Judges reserve the right to remove or disqualify any entry in violation of the rules, in poor taste or not in accordance with the competition standards. They also have the authority to transfer to the correct Class any exhibit that does not meet the requirements of the Division or Class in which it was entered.

Judges are not obligated to reevaluate the awards given to other entries if an entry is disqualified or moved. Awards are not required to be given unless entries are of a minimum merit. No exhibitor shall be entitled to an award that has been disqualified as the result of their own error.

Judging Criteria

All criteria for judging the horticulture competitions are listed in a separate document: Horticulture Judging Criteria.

- Adult Divisions: 401-421
 - o Placed using the American Judging System, wherein exhibits are ranked against one another.
- Youth Divisions: 9401-9421
 - Placed using the Danish Judging System, wherein each entry is judged individually on how well it
 meets a standard rather than how it compares to other entries. Multiple first, second and third
 places may therefore be awarded per Class.
 - Entries will then compete using the American Judging System for special placings (Best of Class, Division Winner and Best of Show).

Comment Sheets

Comment sheets are notes from the judges regarding the entry's performance. Comments from the current competition week will be made available on the relevant entry pick up date. They are also available for viewing or pick up any day of the competition week when OC Fair is open; ask the staff member at the exhibit's information table.
