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## RULES

- 1. Local and State Rules govern this competition.
- 2. Exhibitors are responsible for reading the Competition Guidelines and must abide by them.
- 3. For any questions or concerns regarding this competition, please contact the Garden & Floral Department at GardenFloral@ocfair.com.
- 4. Entries must be made under the name of the individual who prepared it do not use business, fictitious, or group names. Multiple entries submitted by the same individual within the same class will be disqualified.
- 5. The same item cannot be re-entered in subsequent competitions, neither under the original or a different exhibitor's name.
- 6. Entry fees are non-refundable.
- 7. The OC Fair reserves the right to refuse any entry that has a serious disease or insect problem.
- 8. Exhibitors must submit all entries in the correct division/class according to their skill level:
  - **AMATEUR**: For exhibitors who arrange flowers as a hobby or pastime, do not regularly present or promote their work for sale, and/or are students of the art.
  - PROFESSIONAL: For exhibitors who are actively and regularly exhibiting and selling their product(s) or employed in the field.
  - OPEN: These competitions are open to all California residents aged 16+ regardless of skill level.
- g. Judges have the authority to disqualify or transfer to the correct class any exhibit which does not meet the requirements of the division and class in which it is entered. Judges are not obligated to reevaluate a class after moving an entry.

#### 10. Setting Up:

- •Exhibitors have a maximum of **5 minutes** to set up each arrangement.
- Exhibitors may only take photos of their own arrangement(s) and must do so within the 5-minute set-up time.
- Staff maintains the right to ask exhibitors to leave the set-up area at any time.
- 11. Items of great or sentimental value should not be used.
- 12. All exhibitors and entries must be checked in and inside the farm gate by the end of the drop off period (9:30 a.m.) Late entries will not be accepted.
- 13. Claim checks will be provided after exhibits are delivered. Tickets will be provided upon exit.
- 14. Although reasonable efforts will be undertaken to safeguard exhibitors' property, neither the State of California nor the OC Fair & Event Center will be responsible for any loss, damage or theft of exhibitors' property brought on the premises during the period of the OC Fair. Every precaution will be taken in the handling and exhibiting of entries.
- 15. If spoilage occurs prior to the pickup date, the entry will be discarded; the container and any accessories used will be saved and available for pick up.
- 16. Ribbons and entries will be available to pick up during the Entry Pickup dates listed on the cover of this guide. Items not picked up by the final Entry Pickup day become the property of the OC Fair and may be discarded.





## **ELIGIBILITY**

Open to all California residents, ages 16 and older (by July 15, 2022). See specific competition details and "Skill Levels" in the rules.

## **ENTRY LIMIT**

Exhibitors may enter in multiple Divisions and/or Classes each competition date but are limited to **one entry per Class per competition date**.

If multiple entries are submitted by the same exhibitor in the same class, they will be disqualified.

## **HOW TO ENTER**

- Review the Floral Arrangements Rules and OC Fair Guidelines.
- ·Last year's accounts are no longer valid. All exhibitors must create a new account.
- •Click on the "Enter Here" button above or go to: <u>ocgard.fairwire.com</u> and submit your entry(s) online by the online registration deadline (see cover page for deadlines).

#### **Exhibitor Name**

- Entries must be made under the name of the individual who prepared it. This also applies to all youth entries.
- •Enter using the exhibitor's name as it will appear on the display tag.
- •Do not use team, business or fictitious names.
- Provide the most complete information possible for each entry (i.e., Species/Cultivar if known).
- •Enter your information carefully and proofread everything for punctuation, capitalization and spelling to ensure accuracy on exhibit display labels.

### **Entry Confirmation**

- •An email notification and confirmation will be sent immediately after your submission.
- •If the email confirmation does not arrive shortly, please check your Spam/Junk folder before contacting the OC Fair.

### **Entry Fees**

- Entry fees are payable online with a credit card (Visa, MasterCard or Amex).
- ·No refunds will be issued.
- •Fees vary by division; see the division sections later in this guide for specifics.



## OC EXHIBITOR FAIR TICKET

- •Exhibitors will receive one (1) 2022 OC Fair admission ticket at the time of entry delivery.
- •One (1) ticket per exhibitor, not one per entry.
- •Tickets are valid on Wednesdays & Thursdays only and do not require a reservation.
- •Exhibitor must be present to receive a ticket.
- •Tickets are provided to participants so they may come back and view the results of their efforts. Tickets should not be re-sold.

## **ENTRY DELIVERY**

### Competition Delivery: 7:00 a.m. - 9:30 a.m. (see cover page for dates)

Exhibitors will not be admitted to the farm before 7:00 a.m. and must be checked in and inside of the farm gate by 9:30 a.m. with all of their items for their entries to be accepted – no exceptions.

- •Enter Gate 1 off Fair Drive and park in Lot B. Check-in tables will be located next to the Centennial Farm Gate for you to pick up your entry tags, claim check, and/or ribbons.
- •Claim checks will be provided after exhibits are delivered.
- •Entries may be delivered by someone other than the exhibitor.

Please bring other individuals or tools like push carts if you need assistance transporting your entries, especially if large in size or quantity. If you are unsure what is appropriate to enter, or what you can bring to transport your item(s), please contact the farm office prior to the delivery day.

## **ENTRY PICKUP**

Entry Pick-up dates are listed on the front page of this guide. Final Entry Pickup: Monday August 15, 7 - 9:30 a.m.

- •Photo ID is required for pick up.
- •If you are unable to pick up your items, please arrange for someone to pick them up for you.
- •Unclaimed items and ribbons become the property of the OC Fair and will be discarded.
- •No additional phone calls or email notifications will be made.
- •The OC Fair & Event Center is not responsible for exhibits left after this date.





## JUDGING

Qualified judges will be selected by the Program Coordinator from local professionals who are at the top in their field. Each year the Program Coordinator may choose new judges or judges may judge different Divisions from year to year. The judges are professionals and their decisions are final.

**Judging is not open to the public.** Judges reserve the right to remove or disqualify any entry in violation of the rules, in poor taste, or not in accordance with the competition standards. If an entry is disqualified or moved after judging is complete, the judge will not change the status of awards given for other entries.

### **Ranking System**

Placed using the American Judging System where exhibits are ranked one against another.

- •First, Second, Third Place and Honorable Mention may be awarded in each Class if judges so determine. More than one Honorable Mention per Class may be awarded. Judges are not obligated to place entries if they feel they are without sufficient merit.
- First Place Winners will compete for Division Winner.
- •Division Winners will compete for Best of Show.

### **Judging Criteria**

#### **Comment Sheets**

Comment sheets are notes from the judges regarding the entry's performance in the competition. To view or pick up your comment sheets, visit the competition exhibit during the Fair and ask the staff member at the exhibit's info table. They are available for pickup, with claim check or photo ID, any day of the competition week when the Fair is open. Comment sheets from previous weeks may not be saved.

### **Display**

- After judging, entries will be displayed for one Fair week in Farmhouse at Centennial Farm.
- •An image of a ribbon will be printed on the entry card for entries that placed.
- Items will be discarded when they deteriorate. Containers and accessories will be available for pick-up on the scheduled pick-up day (see cover page for more details).

### **Entry & Ribbon Pickup**

Entries and ribbons may be picked up during the Entry Pickup Days (see cover page). If you are unable to pick up your item(s), on these dates, arrange for someone to pick them up for you.

Note that the final pickup date is **Monday, August 15th from 7 – 9:30 a.m.**; items and ribbons left unclaimed after the final pickup date become the property of the OC Fair and may be discarded. Ribbons will not be mailed.

#### **Premiums**

Sweepstakes awards and premiums will be made payable to name of the winning exhibitor as indicated on their online entry account and mailed within 30 business days of the final day of the OC Fair. Signed judging sheets will be used as evidence for payment of premiums; ribbons and tags will not be accepted.





## DRY, SILK & MINIATURE ARRANGEMENTS

Eligibility Open to all California residents, ages 16 and older.

**Entry Limit** 1 per Class, per date **Entry Fee** \$5 per entry **Premiums** First Place \$30 • Second Place \$25 • Third Place \$20

- Setup Time: Floral Arrangement exhibitors have a maximum of five minutes to set up each arrangement.
- •Staff maintains the right to ask exhibitors to leave the setup area at any time.
- Floral arrangements may use commercially grown materials.
- ·Entries should weigh less than 25 lbs.
- Professional floral designers are encouraged to display business cards with their entry(s).

## **DRY ARRANGEMENT (OPEN)**

Competition Date: July 12,

- ·No fresh or silk flowers.
- Acceptable dry materials include: silica gel flowers, freeze-dried flowers, everlasting, glycerinized materials, pressed and air-dried materials.
- Acceptable fillers include: grasses, herbs, grains, woods, pod, raffia, cones and mosses.
- Entries are not to exceed 2 ft. in length, height, or breadth and must be movable by fair staff.

## **SILK ARRANGEMENT (OPEN)**

Competition Date: July 12

- · No fresh or dried flowers or foliage allowed.
- Acceptable items include: decorative wire, stones, glass and sticks.
- ·Flowers may be painted.
- Entries are not to exceed 2 ft. in length, height, or breadth and must be movable by fair staff.

### MINIATURE ARRANGEMENT (OPEN)

Competition Dates: July 26, August 9

- Entries should not exceed 6 inches in length, height, or breadth.
- No fruits, vegetables (fresh or canned), or candy may be used.
- All materials should be secured to a base or container.
- Except Class 06, all miniature arrangements should be over 50% fresh materials.

**Eligibility** Open to all California residents, ages 16 and older.

Entry Limit 1 per Class, per date Entry Fee \$10 per entry

Premiums First Place \$70 · Second Place \$60 · Third Place \$50

- Setup Time: Floral Arrangement exhibitors have a maximum of five minutes to set up each arrangement.
- •Staff maintains the right to ask exhibitors to leave the setup area at any time.
- Entries are not to exceed 2 ft. in length, height, or breadth and must be movable by fair staff for final placement.
- Entries should weigh less than 25 lbs.
- Floral arrangements may use commercially grown materials.
- •Competitions are open to all California residents, ages 16 and up, regardless of skill level.
- Professional floral designers are encouraged to display business cards with their entry(s).

### **IKEBANA (OPEN)**

Competition Dates: July 26, August 9

- · Use of artificial flowers and foliage is prohibited.
- Accessories are permitted, but emphasis should be on the creative use of natural floral and plant materials to symbolically represent specific themes rather than on the excessive use of props.
- No fruits, vegetables (fresh or canned), or candy may be used.

**Eligibility** Open to all California residents, ages 16 and older.

**Entry Limit** 1 per Class, per date **Entry Fee** \$10 per entry **Premiums** First Place \$70 • Second Place \$60 • Third Place \$50

**AMATEUR**: divisions are intended for exhibitors who arrange flowers as a hobby or pastime, do not regularly present or promote their work for sale, and/or are students of the art.

- Setup Time: Floral Arrangement exhibitors have a maximum of five minutes to set up each arrangement.
- Staff maintains the right to ask exhibitors to leave the setup area at any time.
- Entries are not to exceed 2 ft. in length, height, or breadth and must be movable by fair staff for final placement.
- •Entries should weigh less than 25 lbs.
- Floral arrangements may use commercially grown materials.
- No fruits, vegetables (canned or fresh), or candy may be used.
